The Drought Initiative

Support provided to +70 countries to develop national drought plans, moving from a reactive and crisis-based to a proactive and risk-based approach

Collaboration in the stocktaking and review of 29 drought plans submitted in Round 1 (27 new submissions responded to Round 2)

Support to two regional drought risk management projects:

- Central Asia
- Southern Africa Development Community (SADC)

Participation and provision of FAO perspective in the training workshop: *Innovative tools and measures for robust drought risk management – The SADC context*



Capacity Development

Building Forward Better Initiative
