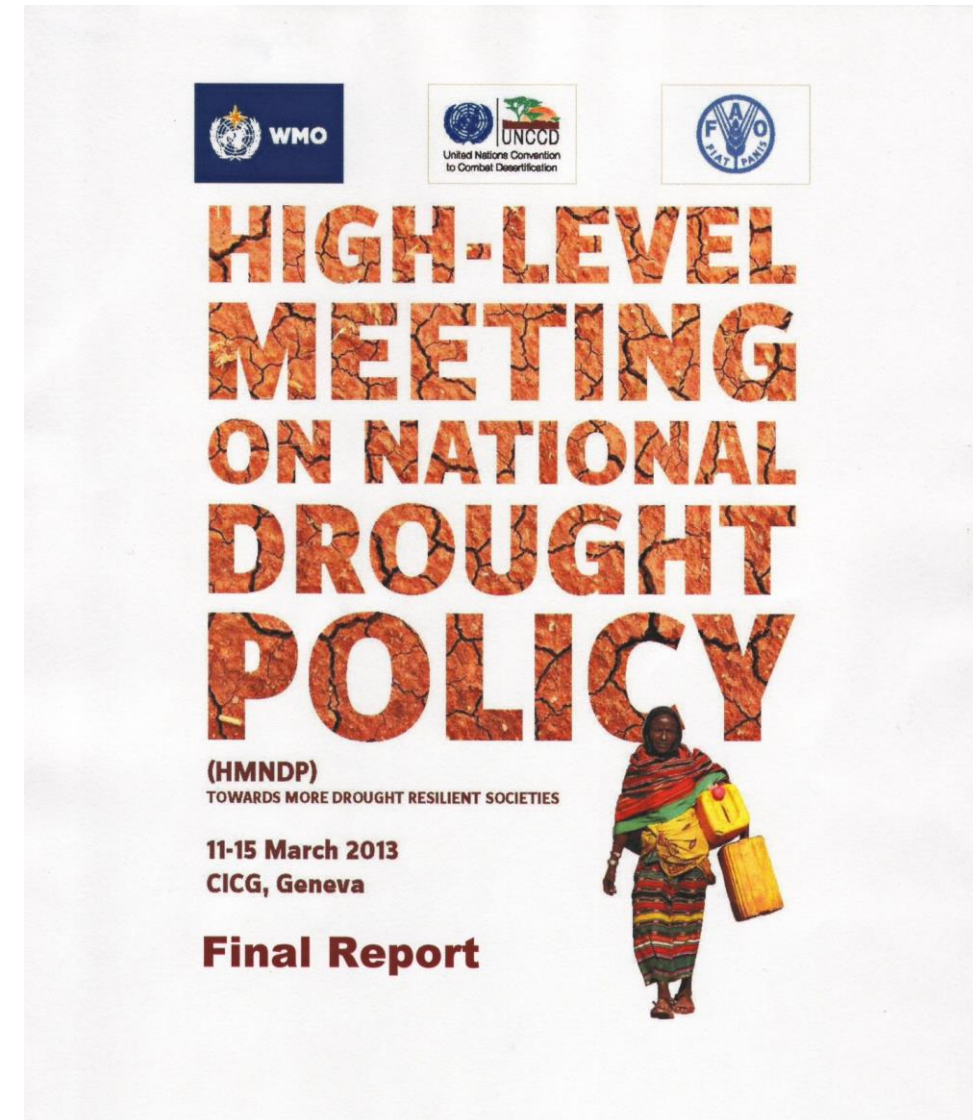
- **IDMP HelpDesk Request** from the Volta Flood and Drought Management project (Western Africa)

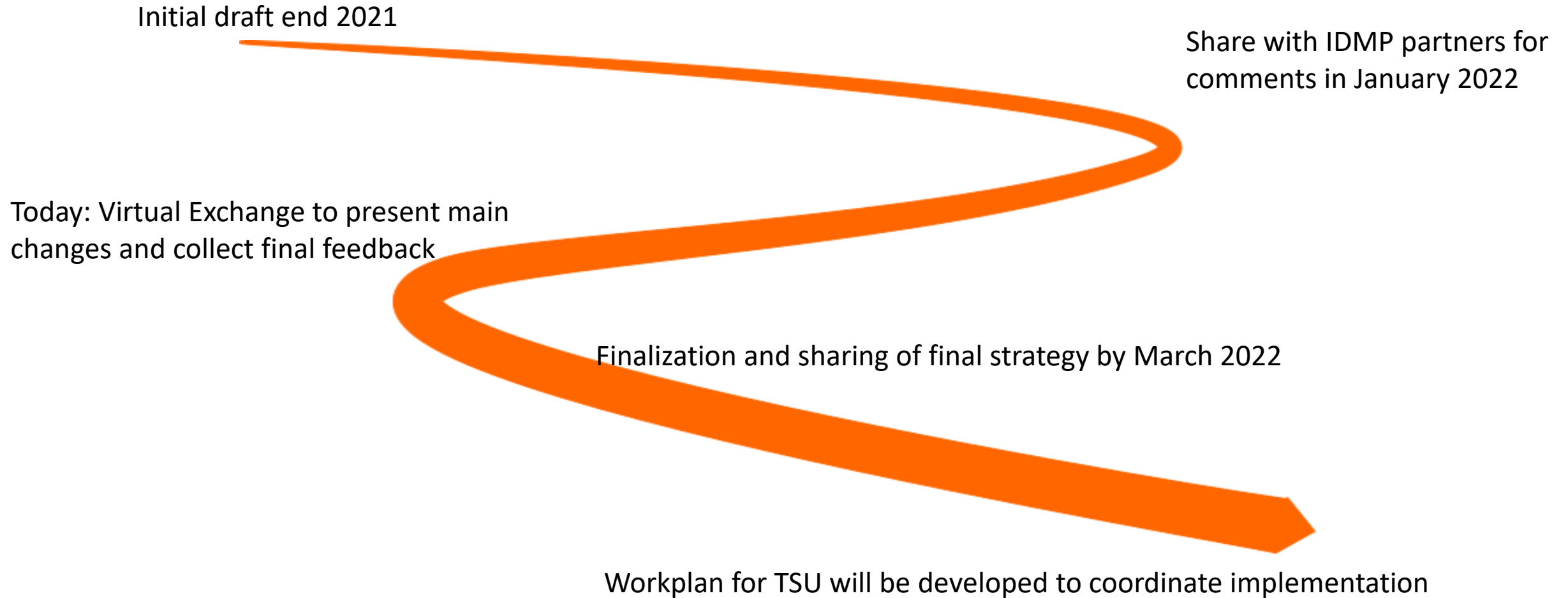

Main threads of comments

- Prominent role of Climate Change
- Extend to 2025 (from 2024) to align better with regional planning
- Targets/KPIs needed?
- How will it be implemented?
- Focus and extension of 2nd pillar (risk& impacts), more guidance needed
- 3rd pillar not addressed
- South America as IDMP region, many existing initiatives
- Help bridging research and operational work
- User survey for HelpDesk, join HelpDesk with APFM
- National IDMP Focal points?
- How to strengthen TSU?

- **Suggested new themes/targets:**
 - Residual risk even after successful IDM: Innovative drought insurance
 - Polycentric governance needed beyond national responsibility
 - Focus on local communities
 - Global drought monitoring system
 - Summer schools for capacity building and youth engagement
 - Develop primer on basics for IDM e.g. for journalists
