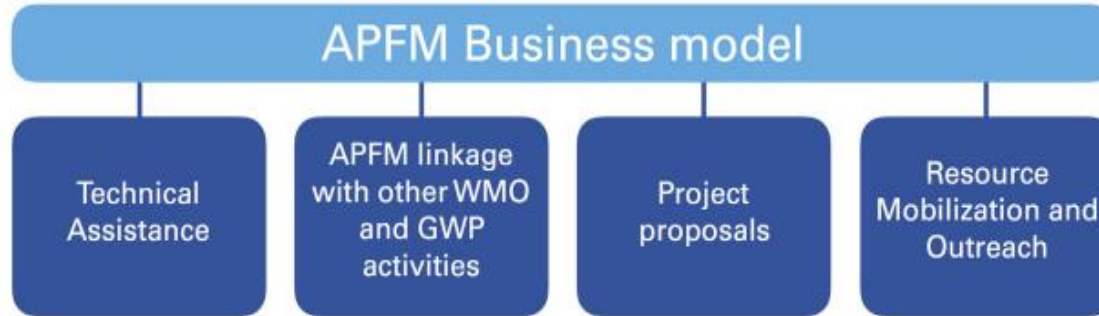

- **Also, a separate joint commitment from APFM and IDMP:** Integrated and people-centered flood and drought Early Warning

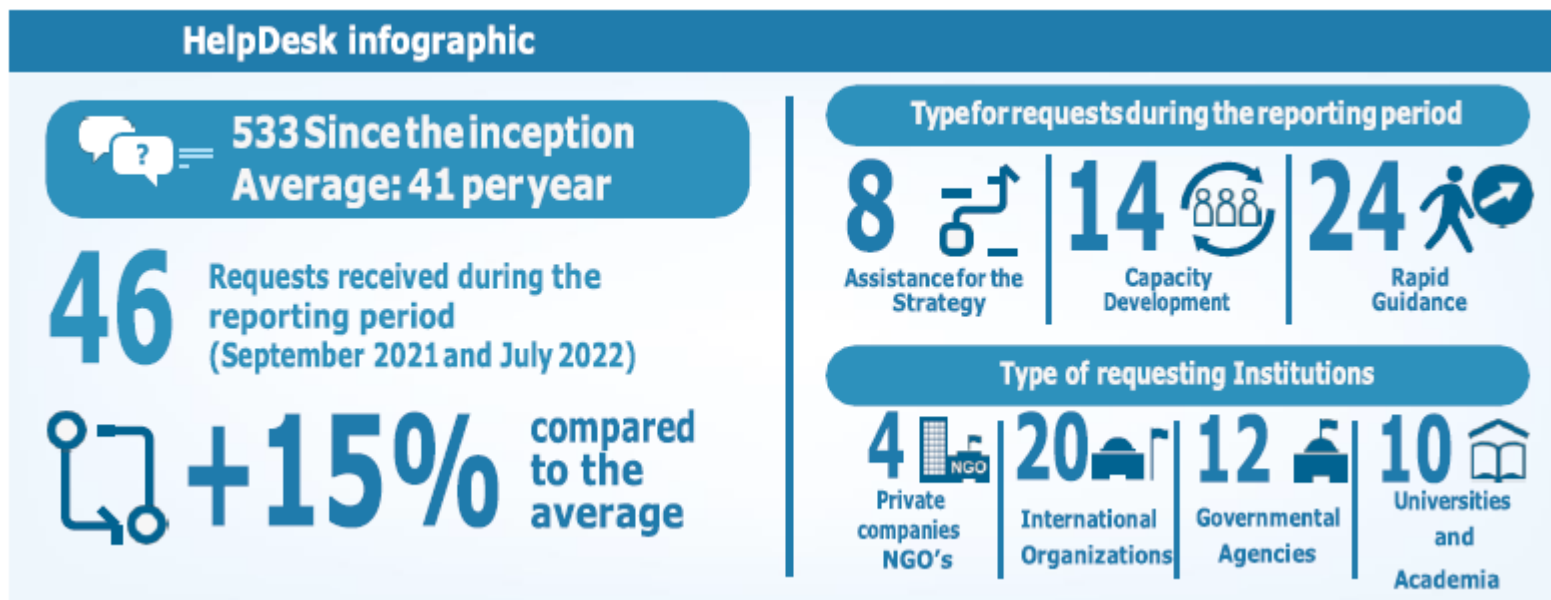


QUICK UPDATES

- The TSU continued to provide Technical Support through IFM HelpDesk



Between August 2022 – 15 March 2023, 20 plus requests were received and provided with assistance (completed and on-going)

QUICK UPDATES

VOLTA FLOOD AND DROUGHT MANAGEMENT (VFDM) PROJECT

- Implementation of third year activities are on-going
- One year no cost extension approved, and project will terminate now in June 2024 (some of activities delayed due to the global Covid-19 Pandemic situation)
- Adaptation Fund Secretariat did a Project Monitoring Mission (PMM) identify good practices, learning, areas of improvement for future regional projects.
- Happy with the progress, suggested WMO to prepare Phase-II of the VFDM project to cover entire region of the six countries and beyond (if budget allows) – Possibly August 2023 or January 2024 submission window
- Operational flood and drought monitoring and IBF (under development)

- **Implementation of CBFM, Risk Mapping and Hydrological modelling activities under CREWS Cambodia and Lao PDR (May 2022 – July 2023)**
- **Implementation of CBFM activities under CREWS Caribbean including gender mainstreaming workshop (April 2022- November 2022)- completed**
- **Implementation of CBFM and gender mainstreaming in Malawi and Costa Rica under the WMO FFGS project**
- **TSU is leading the development of the WMO HydroSOS project in Bangladesh and Nepal (BaNe) region- submitted to the AF in January 2023 for review and approval**
- **Support to the Lake Chad and other regional project concept notes development**

THE WAY FORWARD

- **Continue VFDM Project Implementation (with Executing partners GWP-WA and VBA, and some of the SBPs) planned between March 2023 to August 2023 and beyond.**
- **CBFM activities implementation in Malawi and Central America (October 2022-August 2023) under the framework of FFGS project**
- **Support to CREWS project in Cambodia, Lao PDR and Caribbean**
- **Continue with the development of the HydroSOS BaNe project**
- **Identify new opportunities focussing on E2E-EWS-FF (Integrated Flood and Drought management in general) to develop new project proposals through WMO initiatives, GWP (RWPs and CWPs), and the SBPs.**



THE WAY FORWARD

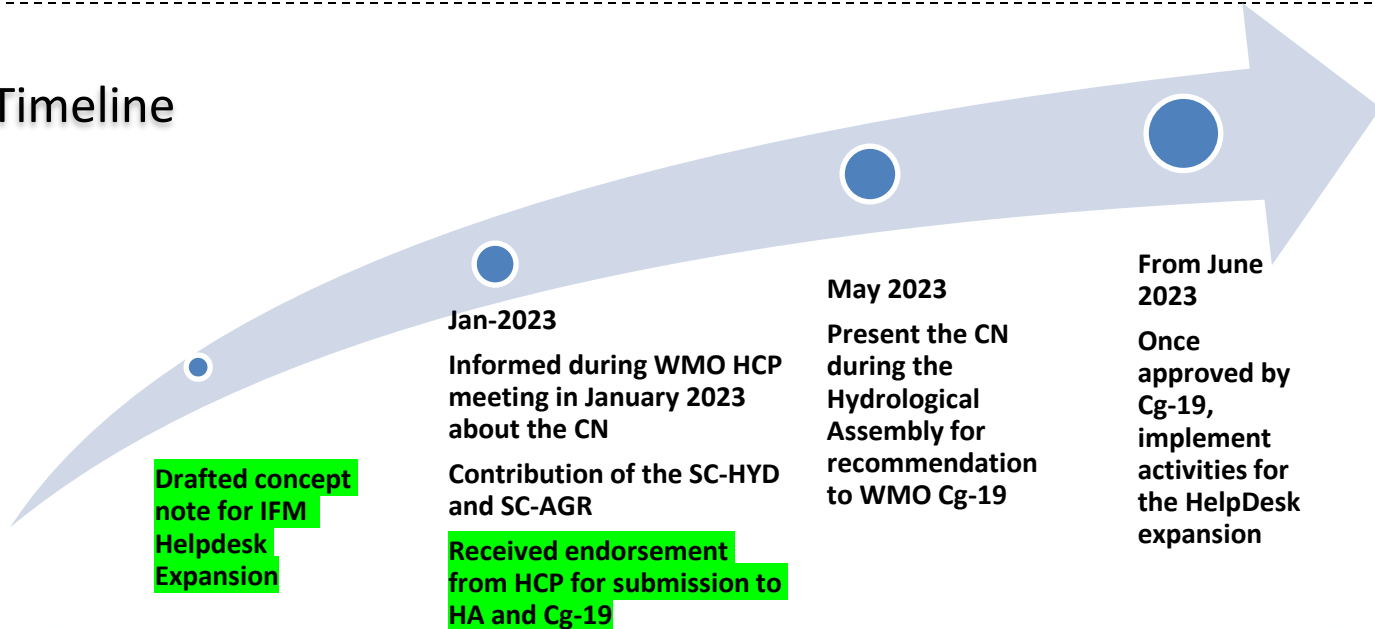
- **Sign LoE with the remaining SBPs**

- **Organize webinars for and with the APFM SBPs - identifying opportunities for collaboration**
- **Explore and discuss with interested SBPs to support for developing on-line tool on the Assessment matrix (AM) available for understanding needs and capacities on E2E-EWS-FF and**
- **Cost-Benefit Analysis for flood forecasting and EWS**

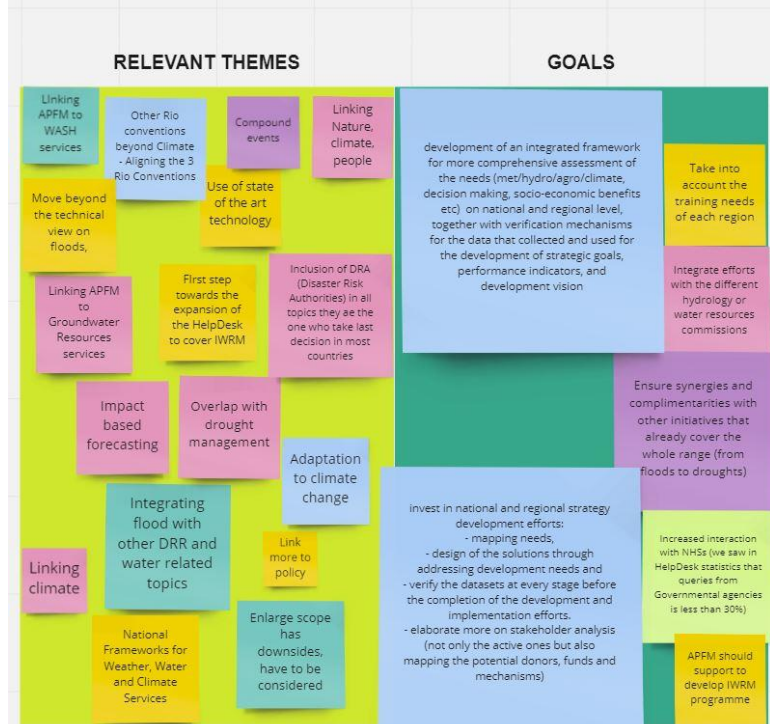
