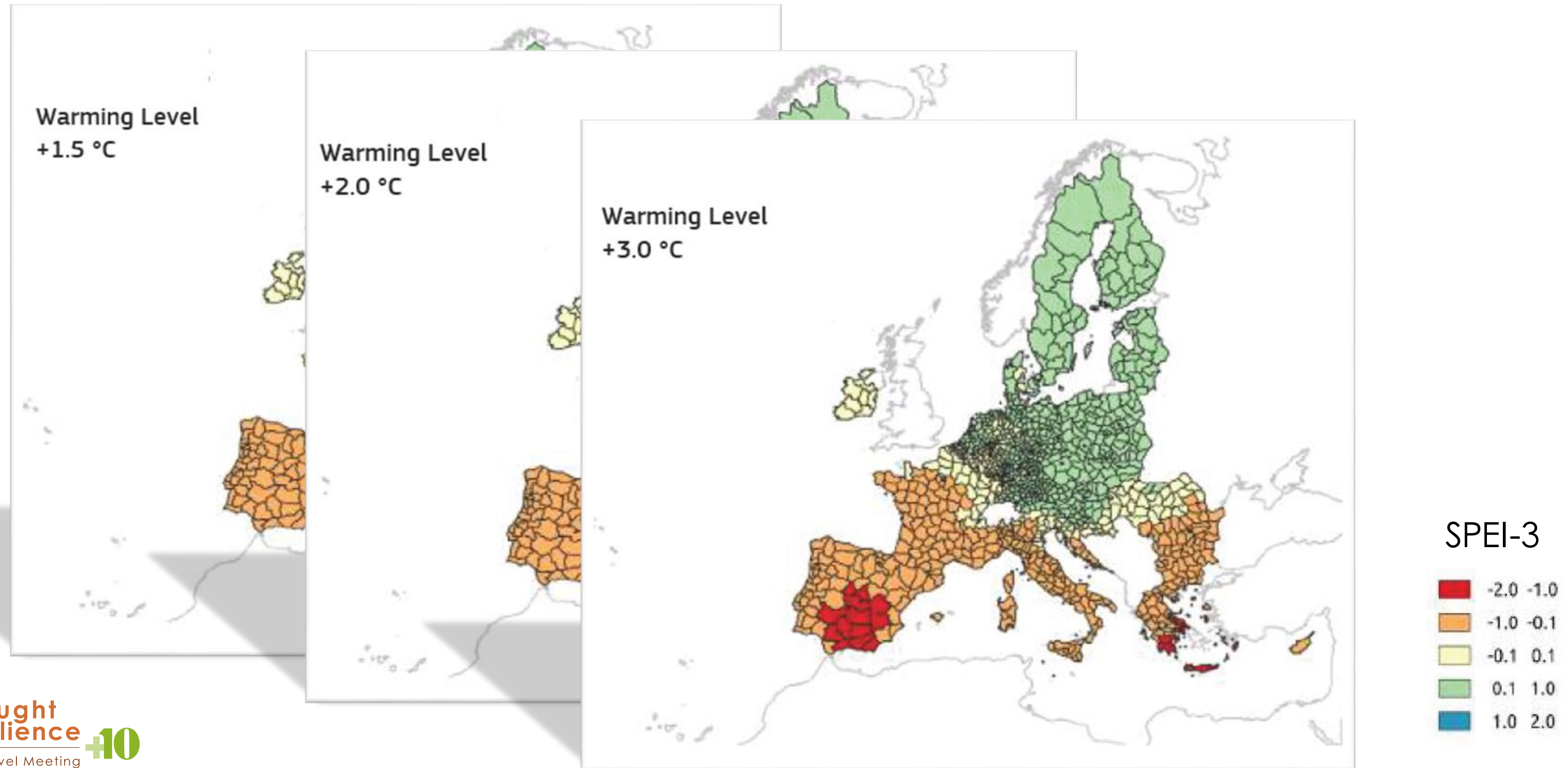

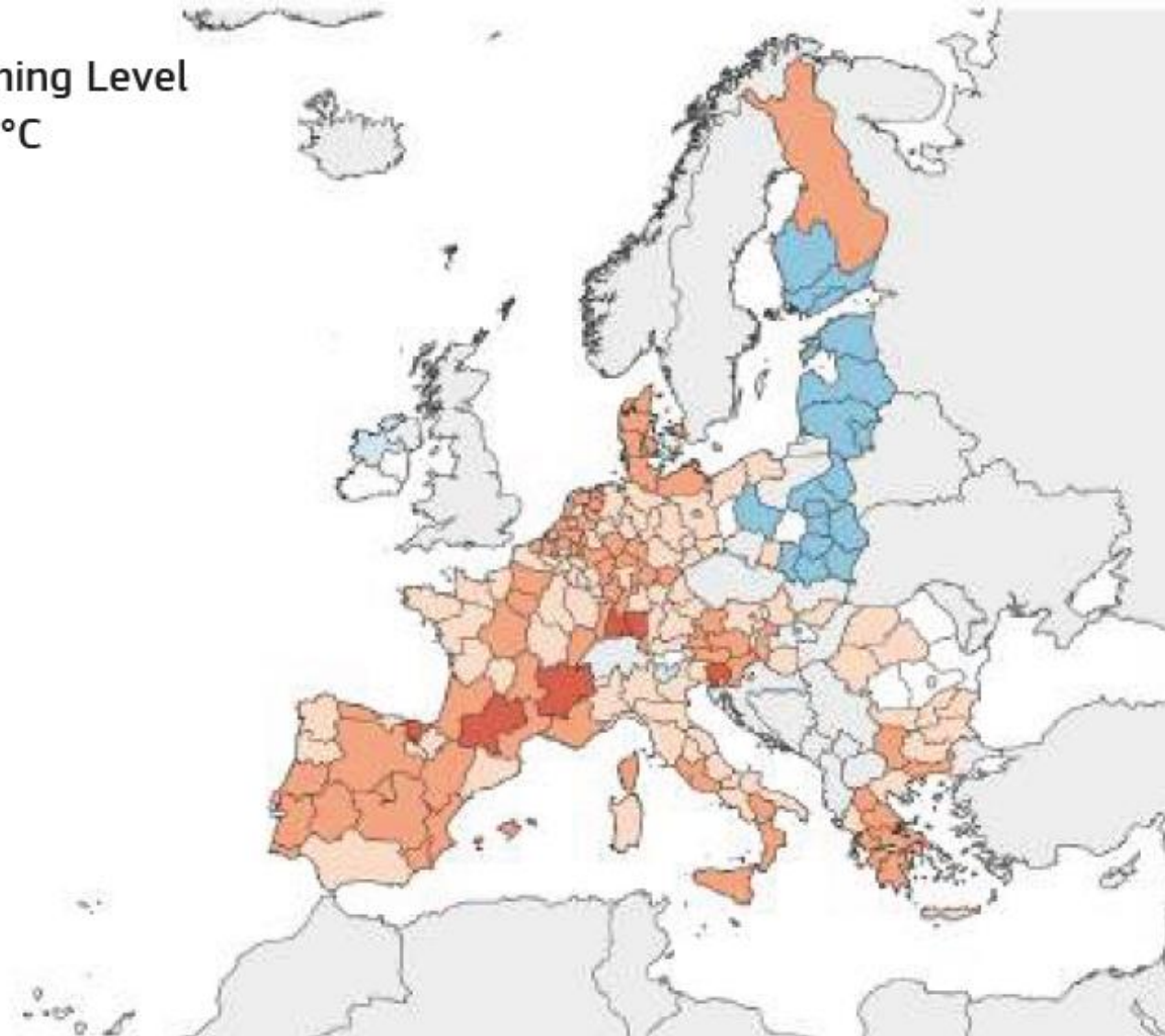

Future change in hazard conditions



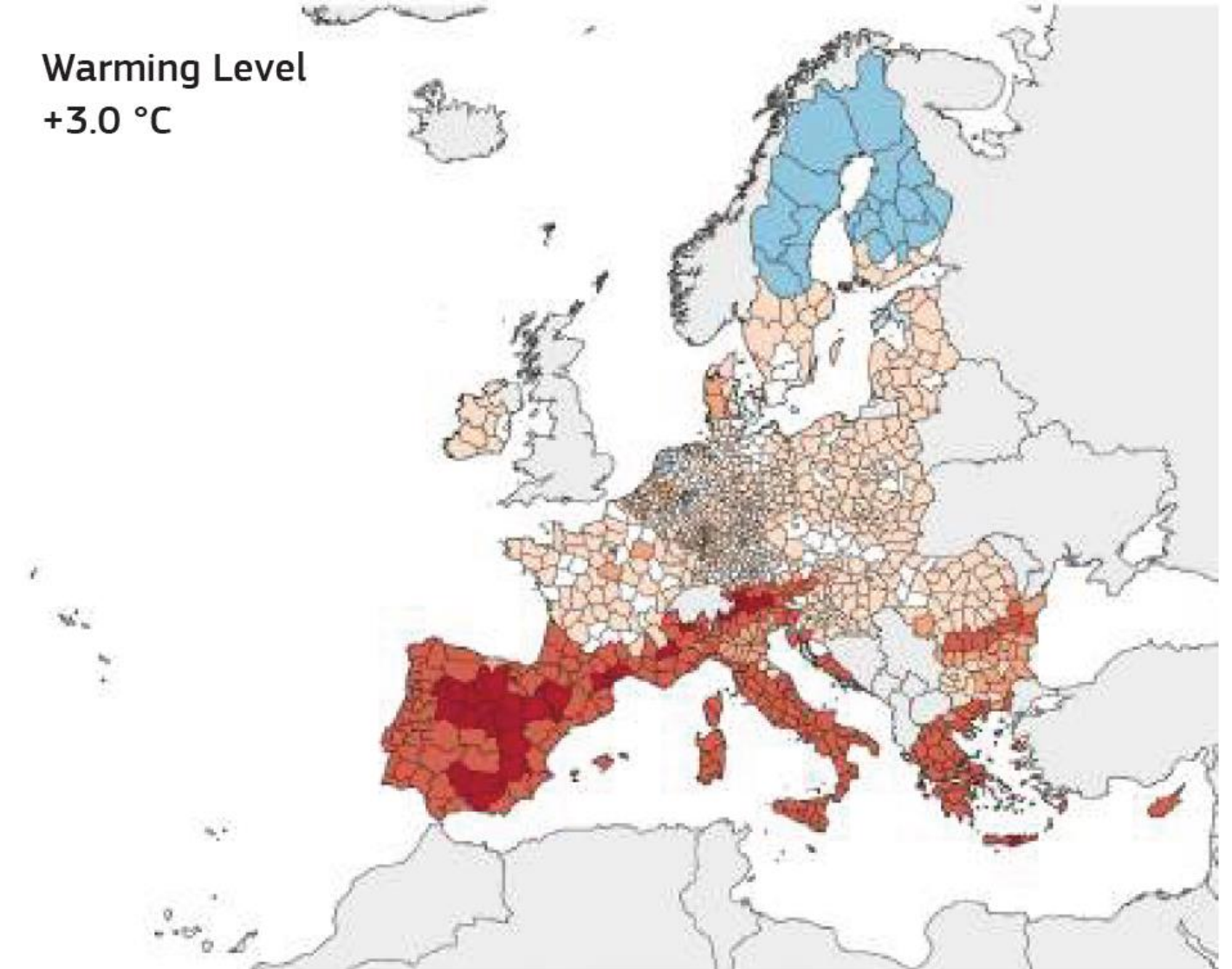
Drought risk under projected climate conditions

Warming Level
+3.0 °C

Terrestrial ecosystems

Projected Loss / Current Loss

- reduction of more than 25%
- reduction between 10% and 25%
- no important variation
- increased by a factor of 1.1 to 1.5

- increased by a factor of 1.5 to 2
- increased by a factor of 2 to 3
- increased by a factor of 3 to 4
- increased by a factor of more than 4

EU Policy framework and tools - drought

- ❑ EU Solidarity Fund to support countries dealing with drought induced damages and losses
- ❑ Common Agricultural Policy: dedicated tools for the agri sector
- ❑ Water Framework Directive: dedicated tools for water bodies and recommendations
- ❑ EU Working Group on Water Scarcity and Drought
- ❑ Copernicus Emergency Management Service - European Drought Observatory
- ❑ Forthcoming EU Water Resilience Strategy

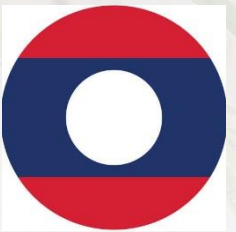

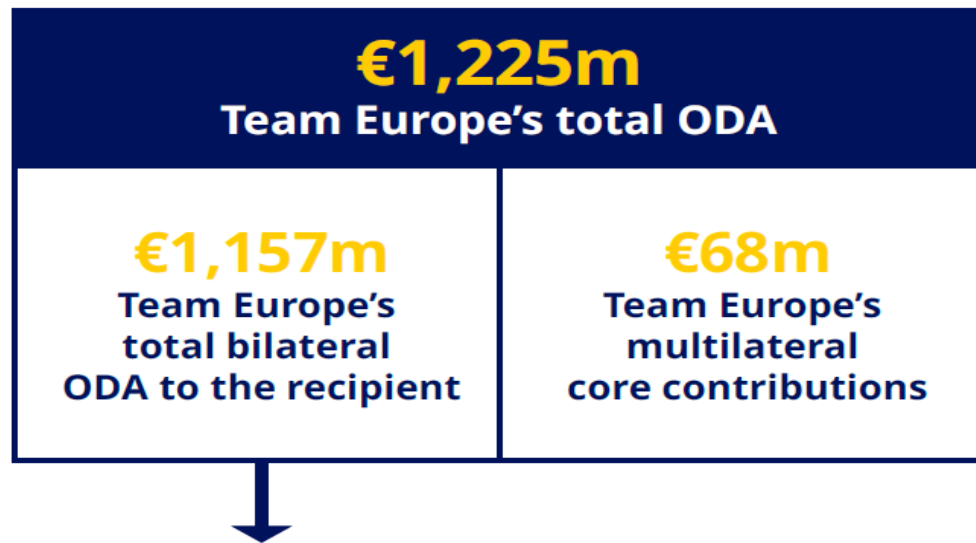


Laos – Green Deal

- enhance the efficiency and water productivity

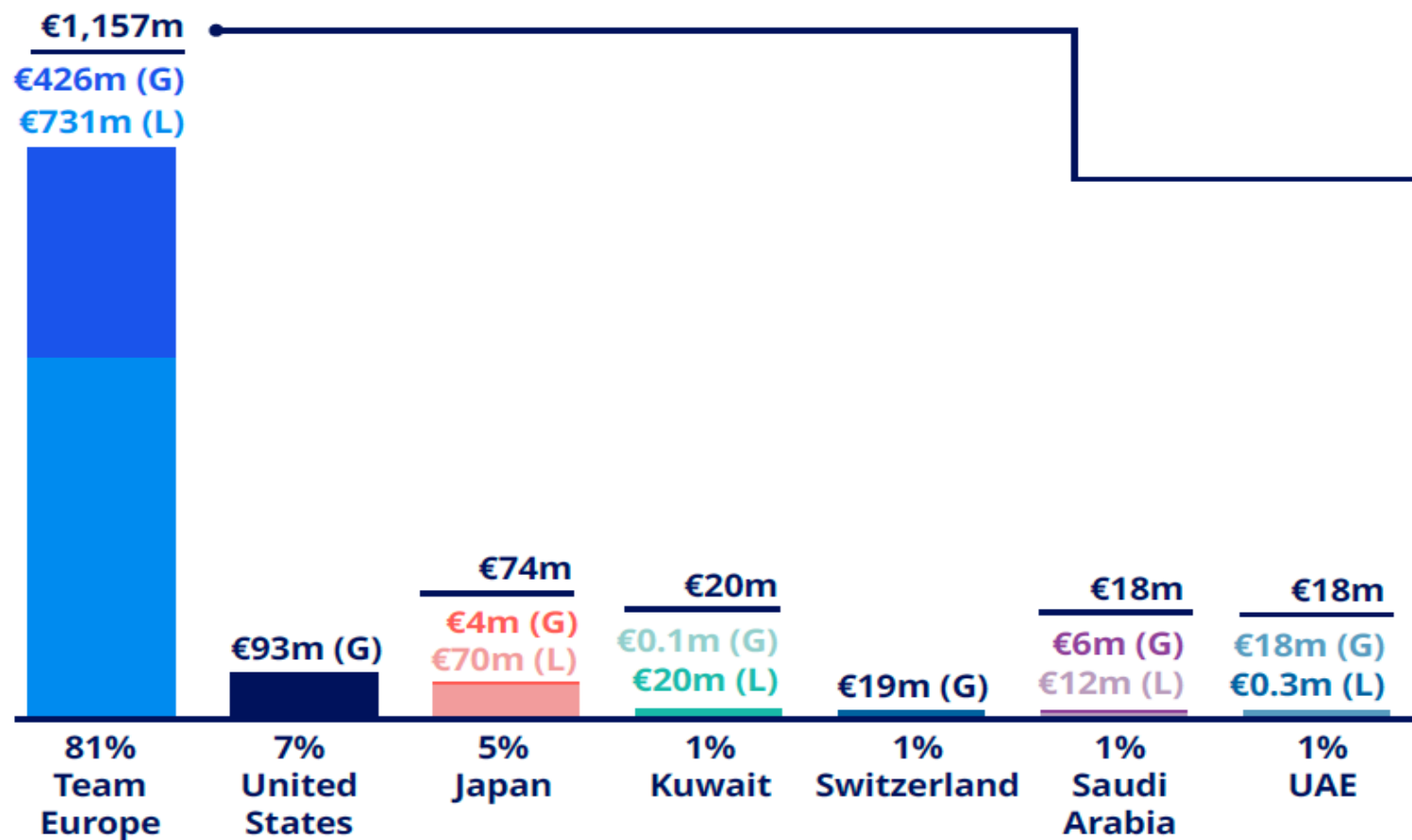

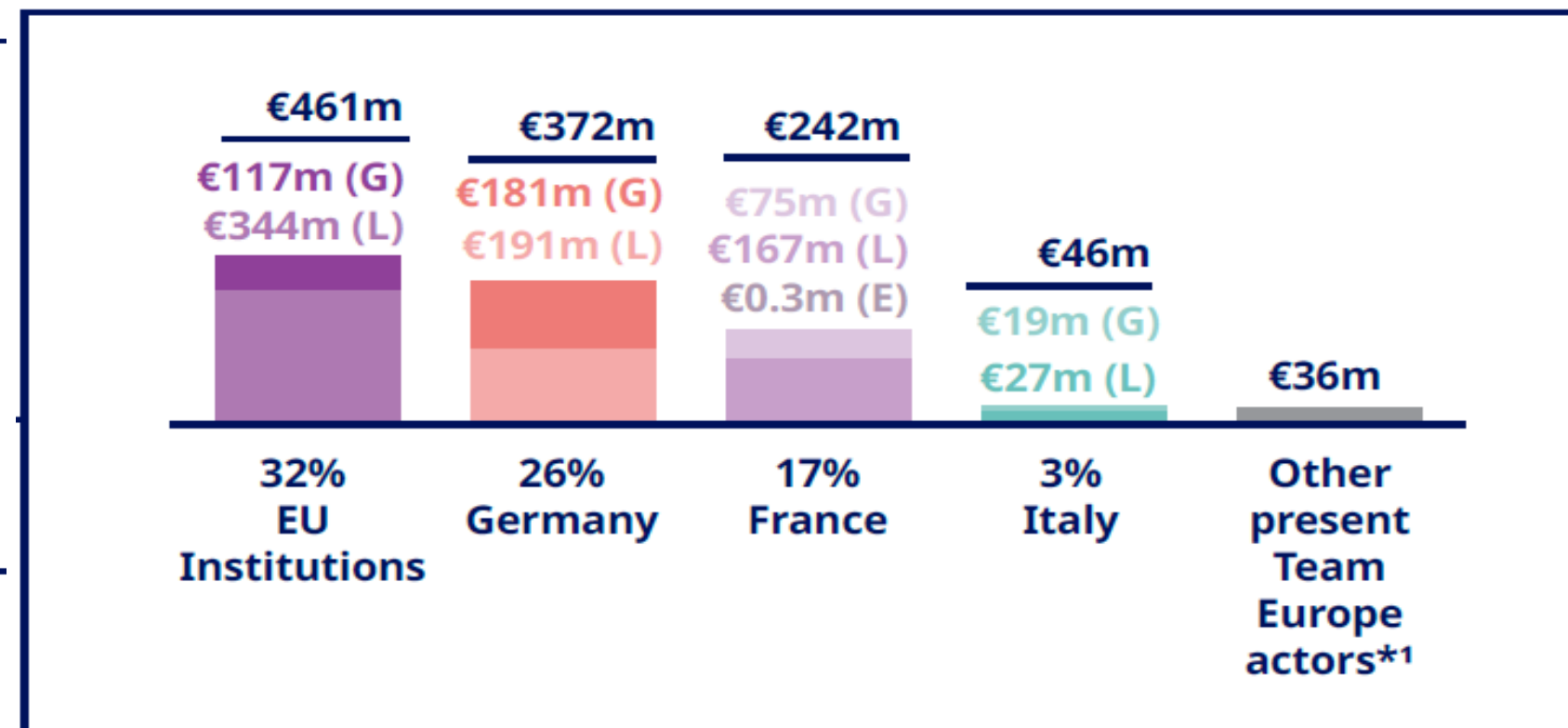
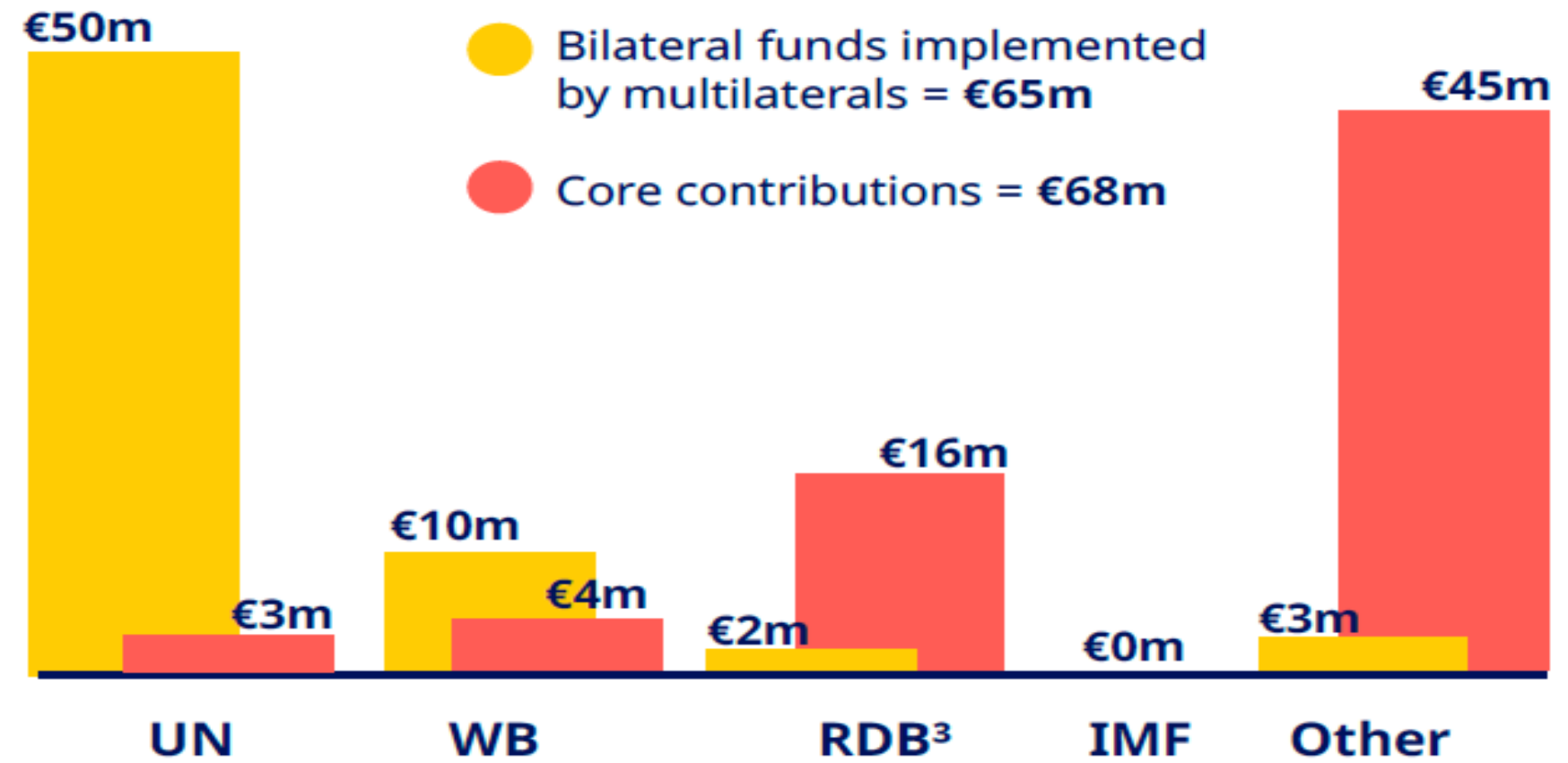
Tunisia's partners in 2021
