




Future change in hazard conditions

Terrestrial ecosystems




Projected Loss / Current Loss

reduction of more than 25%

reduction between 10% and 25%

no important variation

increased by a factor of 1.1 to 1.5



increased by a factor of more than 4

- Common Agricultural Policy: dedicated tools for the agri sector
- Water Framework Directive: dedicated tools for water bodies and recommendations



Tunisia's partners in 2021




