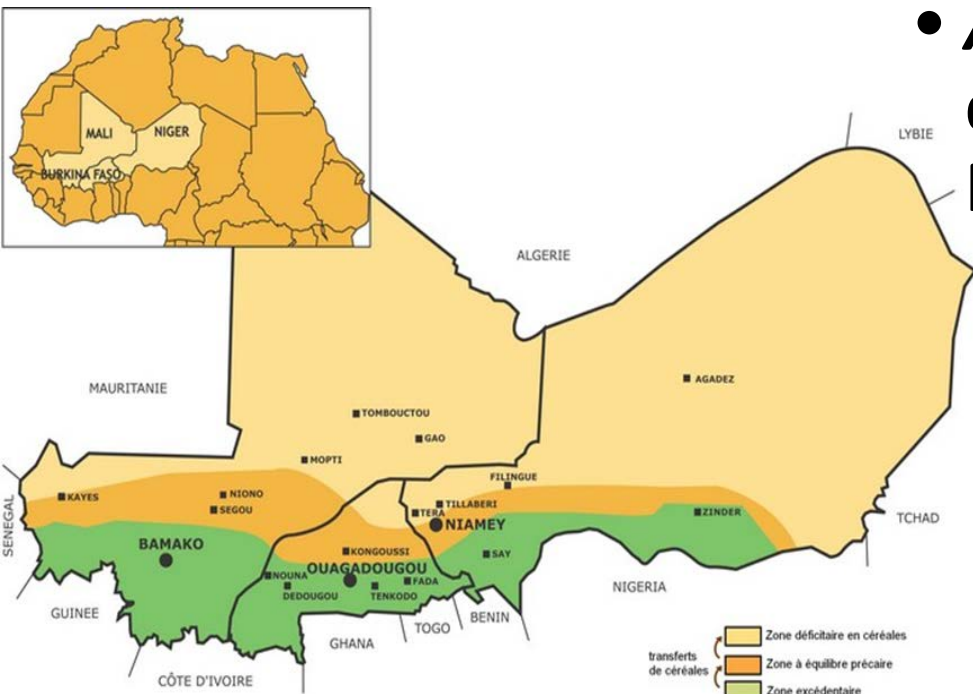

Brief description of the IDMP programme in West Africa



- ***At national level*** : 3 countries selected for demonstration projects: Burkina Faso, Mali and Niger
 - Drought's situation : countries most affected
 - Capacity of the CWP to implement IDMP WAF at national level : HR available and national context
 - On-going initiative
 - Partners interest

- ***At national (3) & regional level (1)*** : Platforms on Drought Management, Capacity building and Technical guidelines on Drought Management.

Main outputs & outcomes to date

Goal 1 : Catalyze change

➤ ***WP1: Drought negative effects are managed in West Africa through the regional initiatives and cooperation.***

- IDMP WAF inception workshop
- Review in details of drought's initiatives/institutions
- Establishment of national & regional platforms to discuss issues related to DM, exchange/consultation place, experiences sharing. Regional members : VBA, UCIN/PACO, WASCAL, 2ie, ECOWAS/WRCU, CILSS, UEMOA . National members ; gvts, meteo, civil society and local NGO.

➤ ***WP2 : Improvment of drought management through national and regional plan/strategies reviewed***

- Assessment of plans and strategies on drought management in the target countries
- Elaboration of a West African technical regional guidelines : ToR available and amendments received from AGRHYMET

Main outputs & outcomes to date

Goal 1 : Catalyze change



➤ ***WP3 : No regret investment are included in some institutions budgets mechanisms/WP 4 : New sources of project financing are leveraged by concerned governments.*** 1 country choosen Mali to support the implementation of the investment plan

➤ ***WP5 : News innovates solutions found for Drought Management in the focus sub area (water resources, agriculture, desertification)***

Agreements have been signed with the CWP of Burkina Faso, Mali and Niger to allow the implementation of pilot projects in the countries during 2016.

Main outputs & outcomes to date

Goal 1 : Catalyze change

- **Mali** : Water and Soil Conservation / defense and restoration of soils for agriculture, for forest and Communication for adaptation to the effects of climate change in the rural commune of Gouendo.

Goal 1 : Catalyze change

- **Burkina Faso** : Promoting innovative drought resilience practices through the establishment of a multifunctional **agroforestry** park in the municipality of Komki-Ipala.

- **Niger** : Development of a site for irrigated crops for the women of the village of Kankantouti in the rural municipality of Torodi

➤ ***WP6 : Stakeholders capacities are built on drought management /New capacities improved by the previous stakeholders trained***

- 21 participants including five (5) women took part in the training of trainers on "Drought risk reduction in the context of Integrated Water Resources Management" with the financial and technical support of Cap-Net.
- Assessment and restitution of the training is still on-going
- Training module is being adapted to West Africa context

➤ **WP7 : The results of IDMP WAF are well shared in the region and the selected countries / Awareness on drought are improved**

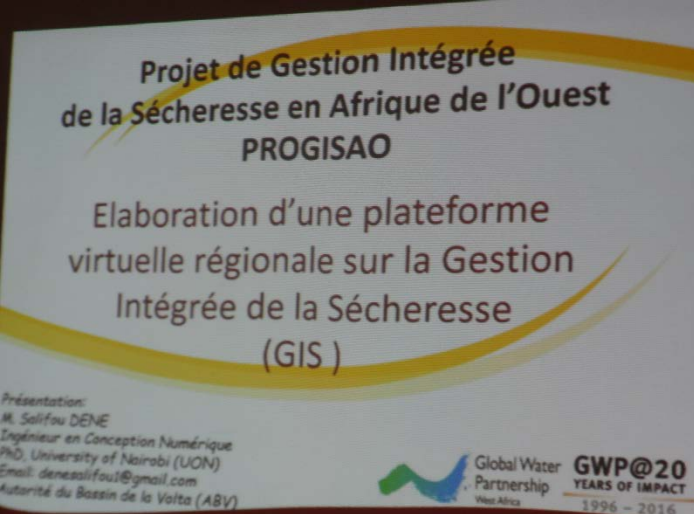

Main outputs & outcomes to date

Goal 3: Strengthen Partnerships



➤ WP8 : Regional/ countries level partnerships' competencies enhanced

- Review of the implementation path was conducted with key stakeholders
- Project demonstration documents was produced with partners
- National and regional platforms are being established with the keys regional (2IE, CILSS, UICN, VBA, WRCU/ECOWAS, WASCAL, Ouaga University) and national actors;
- The structure of the virtual platform will be done by VBA webmaster
- The adapted West Africa manual on Drought with Cap-Net expert with the contribution of members of platforms core group



Challenges



- Technical documents writing with some keys partners (IDMP WAF is running more than its partners)
- Fundraising : GWP is still seeing as a donor at national and regional level. The strategy is to involve partners by their contribution in some activities as demonstration projects, training and platforms actions.
