Background




- **Focus:** To promote drought resilience of countries, communities and ecosystems in the Horn of Africa
- **Project Scope:** 8 countries i.e. Djibouti, Eritrea, Ethiopia, Kenya, Somalia, South Sudan, Sudan and Uganda
- Vulnerability to drought in HOA: High
- **Drought Impacts:** On food security, social stability, environment and the economies of countries
- **Strategy:** Engaging key stakeholders in the region: i.e. Regional Economic Communities (RECs e.g. IGAD), governments (IDDRSI focal points) and partners contributing to droughts in the region.


1. Regional and Transboundary cooperation

3. Knowledge Management on Integrated Drought management in the IGAD region


Cascading knowledge on drought management- Share lessons and best practices in drought management e.g. from case studies within the region
