




Achievements-IDMP HOA

Highlights 2017-2018



Contribution to implementation of global and regional frameworks and commitments at country level

- Engaging countries on NAP processes (Water NAP development) i.e. Burundi, Ethiopia, Kenya, Rwanda, Sudan and Uganda)
- Contribute to NDC country priority areas (related to drought) in Uganda and Kenya

Strengthening capacities and enhancing knowledge for drought management

- Youth and Media practitioners-Kenya and Uganda
- Support to innovative solutions e.g. solar powered irrigation technologies

- CWPs initiating linkages with UN Environment, UNESCO- Are supporting some drought initiatives in the region (leveraging on the work being done e.g. in Sudan)
- Continuous engagement with partners e.g. Regional Economic Communities (IGAD)-coordinating IDDRSI- IGAD Drought Disaster and Sustainability Initiative
- Supported Country Water Partnerships to actively engage and participate in drought conferences and platforms (present actions on ground)
- World Bank engagement initiated- Regional Groundwater Initiative for the Horn of Africa

Milestones

- Strong political commitment
- Strong development partner agreement to sustain the gains e.g. in the NDC partnership plan (DP- taking key responsibilities showing interest and willingness to NDC support)

Resource Mobilization and Overarching work connecting the pillars

Support to project preparation activities For example:

- Drought resilience project- Pastoralists and small-scale farmers in the IGAD region (Adaptation Fund)
- Enhancing Institutional Capacity to Access Climate Funds for Climate Change Adaptation Planning (Green Climate Fund)
- Youth, Media and Water security Empowering the youth and media in promoting climate change resilience and improved livelihoods in Greater Horn of Africa (EU and others)
- Strengthen engagements on the regional ground water *initiative (IGAD/WB)*

- Collaboration on emerging opportunities i.e. Food-Water-Energy Nexus.
- Collaborate with mandated institutions- especially RECs and government institutions
