

Objective: contribute to the development of capacity-building and investment plans on drought management on the basis of community's experiences and improved existing drought management strategies.

IDMP WAF is structured around three specific goals, that are aligned with GWP's theory of change: catalyse change, generate and share knowledge, strengthen partnerships







- **January 2015**: IDMP WAF inception workshop
- **Phase 1 : 2015 2017** : Implementation of 3 national pilot project and regional activities (capacity building and elaboration of technical documents)
- **Phase 2 : 2018 2019** : Phase 1 activities monitoring/evaluation and fundraising activities
- From January 2020: Resource Mobilization and Overarching work connecting the pillars
- The programme has focused so far on the regional level and on activities in Burkina Faso, Mali, and Niger, and it is implemented by GWP West Africa, in collaboration with regional, national, and local partners.

Establishment of 3 national and regional group on drought experts



Platforms on Drought management were put in place at regional and national levels.

These platforms are an exchange/consultation place, sharing of experiences, information, analysis and advice between national and regional partners institutions working in the area of drought and climate change.

Members of the national (10 per country) and regional (14 members) have provided valuable input and technical assistance to IDMP WAF.



Analysis of plans, strategies on drought ...

INTEGRATED DROUGHT MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME IN WEST AFRICA
(IDMP WAF)



- There is an array of plans, programs, policies, strategic documents, and so on giving in principle a formal institutional framework and guidelines for the implementation of actions by main actors.
- However, these different strategic documents are not sufficiently disseminated through channels that are accessible to all, and are mostly poorly known and even unknown to certain stakeholders involved in the fight against drought.









Joint demonstration project in Niger: Development of a site for irrigated crops for the women of the village of Kankantouti in the rural municipality of Torodi







Joint demonstration project in Burkina Faso: Promoting innovative drought resilience practices through the establishment of a multifunctional agroforestry park in the municipality of Komki-Ipala.











Joint demonstration project in Mali: Water and Soil Conservation / defense and restoration of soils for agriculture, for forest and Communication for adaptation to the effects of climate change in the rural commune of Gouendo.











Main results achieved from joint demonstration projects

- Around 500 people including more than 100 women were mobilized on the 3 sites including local and political authorities and 200 people were involved in the implementation, including 120 women (40% young ladies) and 60 young people.
- 3,000 plants produced on the Burkina Faso site have contributed to 1 hectare of degraded land recovered
- 8 ha of land restored in the rural commune of Gouendo in Mali.
- 25 to 200% increase in women's harvests in Torodi, Niger.
- 41.28 tons of compost produced in Gouendo, Mali, contributing to the increase of millet and sorghum production





Main results achieved from joint demonstration projects

- Support for I3N activities in Niger
- 500 bunches of hay produced in Komki-Ipala in Burkina Faso, representing an average gain of € 1,200 obtained through the sale of fodder after 1 year!
 - Some capacity building actions supported the activities on the ground:
 - 30 farmers trained in CES/DRS and composting techniques in Mali,
 - more than 30 young people trained in nursery plant construction techniques,
 - more than 30 young farmers trained in assisted natural regeneration techniques,
 - more than 100 women coached in improved market gardening techniques
 - 6 sensibilisation meetings on the fight against the effects of climate change.





Capacity building of keys national and regional stakeholders



- Training of trainers was held from 25 to 29 April 2016 at Ouagadougou on "drought risk reduction in the context of Integrated Water Resources Management" with the financial and technical support of Cap-Net.
- 21 participants including five (5) women from the private sector, government institutions and civil society from Burkina Faso, Mali, Niger and some regional institutions based in Ouagadougou took part to the training.





Capacity building of keys national and regional stakeholders

Regional training on "Integrated drought and flood management: Contribution of media men/women in the advocacy and awareness-raising in West Africa".



The workshop was held from 20 to 22 November 2018 at Ouagadougou (Burkina Faso) and provided to 20 journalists from Benin, Burkina Faso, Côte d'Ivoire, Ghana, Mali, Niger and Togo, with robust knowledge to allow them to make productions in their media organizations with relevant and well sourced information

- A support to countries to integrate drought resilience into NAP development and implementation process.







3 new pilot project financed by **Fond vert Québec, ISW** α **GWP** started November 2017 with the collaboration of **ISW, CWP of Benin** α **Burkina Faso** and **Eau Vive Togo**.

PLAN FOR 2020 - 2022



IDMP WAF will continue to contribute to GWP new 2020-2025 Strategy. Specifically some GWP-WAF actions will be supported through the 3 pillars of IDMP:

- Monitoring and EWS: Youth"TonFuturTonClimat" project will work closely with
 Meteorological services of Benin, Burkina Faso and Togo for agriculture planning activities
 and synergies will be made with actions on EWS through GWP-AO initiatives.
- Vulnerability and Impact assessment: Support to West Africa countries selected for the
 elaboration and the validation of National Drought Management Plans and Promotion of
 the training manual on Drought risk reduction in integrated water resources management
 with West Africa academic institutions.
- **Drought mitigation, preparedness and response**: IDMP-WAF will be supporting Volta project through actions to mitigate drought impacts and prepare to respond to drought emergencies more effectively.
